

How to get there

S **Urban rail:**
S1 bis S8 to Hackerbrücke
S7, S20, S27 to Heimeranplatz then U4, U5

BUS **Underground:**
Linie 58 to Georg-Hirth-Platz, Beethovenplatz or Goetheplatz
Linie 131/132 to Hans-Fischer-Straße
Linie 134 to Theresienhöhe

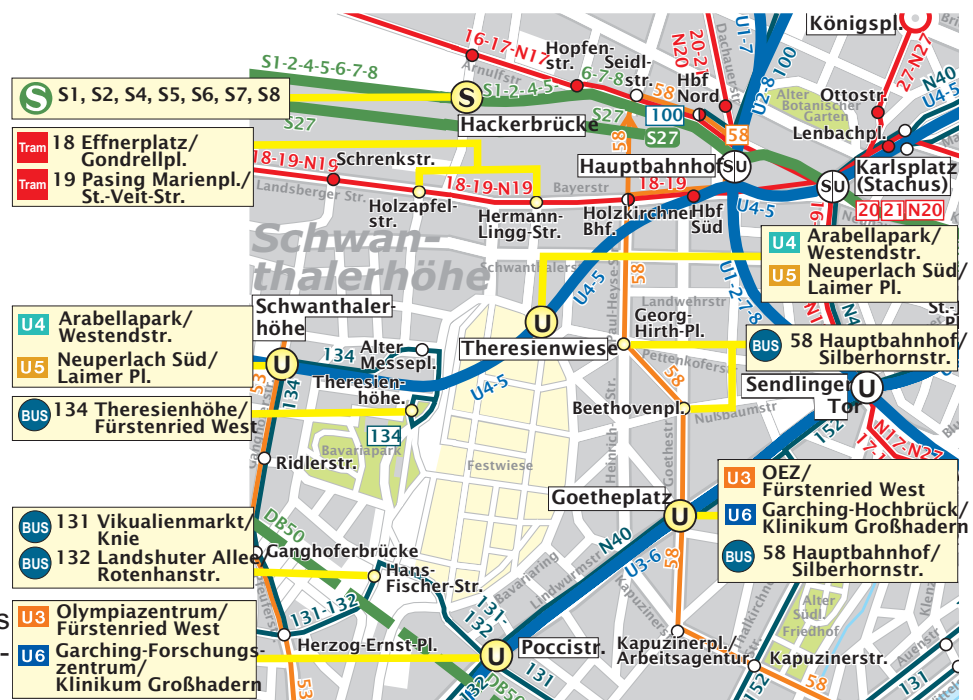
U U3, U6 to Goetheplatz or Poccistraße
U4, U5 to Theresienwiese or Schwanthalerhöhe
Tram Linie 18, 19 to Holzapfelstraße or Hermann-Lingg-Straße

How regular are the train services?

S S-Bahn (urban rail) trains run on the main route between **Ostbahnhof and Pasing** via Marienplatz, Hauptbahnhof and Hackerbrücke and in the opposite direction every 2 to 5 minutes. The last trains travel in the direction of Ostbahnhof at around 1 a.m. and in the direction of Pasing at around 1.45 a.m.. At weekends, the last trains in both directions leave at around 2.30 a.m.

On **S-Bahn (urban rail) routes into suburban areas** close to the city centre services run daily at 20/minute intervals all through the day until around midnight.

U All **U-Bahn (underground)** trains run daily at least every 10 minutes until approx. 1 a.m. and therefore at least every 5 minutes to/from Goetheplatz, Poccistraße, Theresienwiese and Schwanthalerhöhe.



If it gets late ...

The MVV also provides a special night service at Oktoberfest time:

- **U-Bahn** trains run until approx. 2.00 a.m. in the nights from Friday to Saturday and from Saturday to Sunday as well as before public holidays.
- On each of the **S-Bahn (urban rail) lines S1 to S8** an extra night service will be operated in each direction in the nights from Friday to Saturday, Saturday to Sunday and before public holidays, departing from the city centre between 2.10 a.m. and 2.40 a.m. (each running to/from the end of the line). Additional S-Bahn trains will run in the evenings during Oktoberfest.
- The **city nightlines network** will also continue to run: at weekends, as well as before public holidays, outer districts will be accessible throughout the night by services on four tram lines and six bus lines running at half-hour intervals. On working days, that is in the nights from Sunday to Monday until Thursday to Friday, four tram lines and one bus line will be in hourly operation.
- Additional buses will run in the district of Munich in the evenings, provided by the MVV-Regionalbusverkehr (regional bus service).

Our tip:

Theresienwiese underground stop (U-Bahn) is most highly frequented and often overcrowded. Please use other stops around the Oktoberfest instead, where possible.
